In his 22 years as a head coach at all levels of volleyball from NAIA to NCAA I, Coach Callender has amassed over 560 wins to put him as one of the winningest active volleyball coaches in the country.

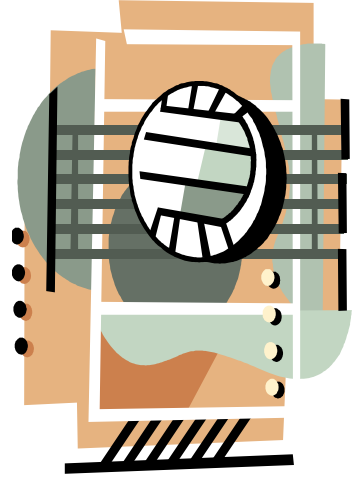
Under Callender's guidance, the Mustangs have moved from the worst volleyball program in NCAA II ten years ago, to one of the best. In fact, WNMU is still in the NCAA record book for the longest consecutive matches lost (44), but those days are over and people don't schedule the Mustangs for an easy win. The Mustangs are coming off a four year stretch of 89-24, including two conference championships and consecutive trips to the NCAA II National Championship Tournament.

His sparkling coaching career has seen 58 All-Conference and 16 All-Americans, numerous all-academic awards recipients. The Mustangs have received the AVCA Molten Team Academic Award. He has been chosen Conference and District Coach of the year five times and has taken his teams to the National Championships eight times.

Coach C. served for over 20 years as a head coach/clinician for the USAV Volleyball Development Camps. He also conducts numerous satellite camps in the summer and presented for the NCAA / AVCA National Coaches Convention, and serves on numerous NCAA and AVCA committees.

Camp is designed to maximize contacts for the players and to have a lot of fun. This four day camp will allow the players to have approximately 2 weeks of volleyball training loaded into four days. You won't see players sitting around here, they will be involved touching volleyballs and improving their skills!! Camp is open to players in grades 4 and up, including beginner, intermediate and advanced skill levels. The training sessions will target all individual skills and strategies involved in the game of volleyball. Each of the sessions will also include position specific training (outside hitter, setter, middle hitter/blocker, defense specialist, libero). Evening sessions will include team play. Individuals will be grouped to form additional teams.

Camp 1: \$225 overnight (includes all meals and lodging) \$150 commuter (includes L & D)

Camp 2: \$75 commuter only (includes lunch)

Groups of 8 or more receive a discount!

All campers receive a free T-shirt!!

Note: A \$50 nonrefundable deposit must accompany the individual camp application.
